



# **Hebron Holy Sites & Attractions**



### Avraham Avinu Synagogue

The Avraham Avinu Synagogue, built in 1540 by exiled Spanish Jews escaping the Inquisition, was the center of the Jewish quarter of Hebron. The once beautiful synagogue was razed to its foundation under Jordanian occupation and turned into a sheep pen. In 1976 the Jewish community restored the synagogue using listatior photographs receiting on exact replica with a new women's section. Today once again it stands in the center of the neighborhood named after the synagogue surrounded by a yeshiva, kollel, kindergartens, clinics and community offices.



Tel Hebron Observatory and Neighborhood

Tel Hebron, also known as Admot Yishal, the original Hebron in Biblical times was fortified with massive stone walls. Its main water source was "Abroham's Spring" which can be visited to this day, in 1811, the land was purchased by the Jewish community but it took until 1884 for Jewish framilies to finally resettle the area. The Belt Menachem apartment complex was completed in 2005 and the Hebron Observatory was established on the roof in 2014, giving visitors a panoramic view of both Jewish and PA-controlled Hebron and its sites.



### Tombs of Ruth and Yishai

An ancient structure near Tel Hebron is identified as the burial place of Yishal (father of King Dovid) and Ruth, the "Queen Mother" of the Dovidic Annotary, Jewe have wearnisped here for many generations, customantly against partners and such partners and such partners and the State of the Ruth pining the Jewish people and finally the birth of King Dovid. The Tomb complex has been extensively renovated in the last few years, and features an ancient synagogue and scribol writing prom, as well as areas suited for family visitation. The Tomb of Ruth and Yishai stands as a complement to the Tomb of the Forefathers and is a testament to King Dovid's rule in Hebron for seven years before moving to Jerusulem.



### The Hebron Museum and Beit Hadassah

Built in 1893, Beit Hadassch was a local medical center serving Jews and non-Jews allies in the 1928 Habron massacra Jews were nurdered at the alte, and the survivors departed. ### Ma'arat HaMachpela

Hebron, City of the Fathers and Mothers, commands a unique and central position in Jewish history. The Patriarchs and Matriarchs – Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Sarah, Rebecca & Leah – the founding family of the Jewish people, are interred here. It was here that Abraham made the first purchase of Jewish property in the Land of Israel and therefore Hebron stands for an eternal bond between the People and the Land of Israel. Ma'arat HaMachpela is considered the second holiest site in Judaism, the roots of Jewish people-hood.



### Tel Hebron Archaeological Park

Tel Hebron, in partnership with the Jewish Community of Hebron, is an excavation performed by the Israel Antiquities Authority in 2014 and was opened to the public in 2018 as an official site of the Israel National Parks Authority, it contains artifacts of Jewish communities from the Consantie, Israelite, Early Roman, Lafe Roman and Byzantine periods. 




